The Legacy Continues

A record number of Shiawassee area students received scholarships to the University of Michigan this year, with 34 starting at Ann Arbor and 27 attending the Flint campus (see page 2).

The philanthropic work of the Cook Family will continue and grow in the year ahead. The Bruce and Jacqueline Cook Scholarship is now permanently endowed at the University of Michigan, joining the Donald Cook Scholarship to provide support to the leaders and best of high school graduates from the greater Shiawassee region.

The Cook Family Foundation is expanding its scholarship efforts, working with the Kuhlman Family to encourage students to attend the University of Michigan in Ann Arbor. As well, the Foundation provides a \$3,000 scholarship to any of the three campuses of UM for Shiawassee area students with a 3.5 GPA or higher. *(continued on Page 2)*

Shiawassee Scholars Program in its 23rd Year

For 23 years, the Shiawassee Regional Education Service District (SRESD) has supported academic achievement with support from the Cook Family Foundation. Every year, the top eighth grade students are identified by their high scores on the SAT (Scholastic Aptitude Test). In March, the newest group of Shiawassee Scholars from eight schools were recognized at a reception where they heard an inspiring talk from Tim McKay, Professor of Physics and Associate Dean for Undergraduate Education at the University of Michigan.

Shiawassee Scholars participate in several programs to prepare them for success in college, starting with a three-day trip to Ann Arbor. Through their high school careers, Scholars are invited to workshops, information sessions, and in-school "Dish and Dessert" events to help them plan their high school curriculum, seek out on-line and dual enrollment classes, and practice their test-taking skills.

Scholarships are available to the Shiawassee Scholars for summer academic programs. This enables high school students to learn a subject in-depth on a college campus with other talented students from around the country. Scholars have attended programs in healthcare, engineering, meteorology, environment and other topics at Michigan Tech, Michigan State, Johns Hopkins, Wake Forest, and other universities.
